## ARCIRAGAZZI PORTICI

Arciragazzi is a national association founded in the 1981, which promotes the Rights of Children and of Adolescence promulgated by ONU (20 November 1989). It ensures the value and the quality of life of children and adolescents.

Arciragazzi use non-formal education as a method of first impact: these methods are fundamentally guided by the language of game, universally recognized as the most natural stimulus to the participation of children and young people. Arciragazzi so considers the game, a powerful tool for civic and cultural growth, and promotes the direct participation of children and young people in the development and management of projects, activities and discussions with the public authorities, schools and with Italian and European institutions.

The staff is completely made off volunteers.

Arciragazzi Portici (in line with the aims of statues of National Arciragazzi agency) aims to:

- To spread the knowledge among adults and children about Children's Rights, referring to the 1989 UN Convention;
- To promote the game in town squares and a culture of "Fit for Children";
- Promote and encourage the interpersonal dynamics with particular attention to multi-ethnic, generational, gender integration;
- Propose activities that enhance the participation of children;
- Support awareness campaigns and socially relevant initiatives, in cooperation with similar associations and government institutions;
- Promote voluntary service;
- Support the family and school to be an alternative educational in the leisure activities.

## **Estonia – Seiklejate Vennaskond**

Seiklejate Vennaskond is a group of young active and optimistic people who are all interested in different areas of life.

On national level we promote integration between different ethnic groups through adventure tourism.

We also have participated in different youth exchanges and seminars concerning equality, media impact, innovation, fight against racism, xenophobia and HIV prevention. Our group gathers every month to take up new ideas and think how to put them into practice. We sincerely believe that the young people today can make a difference and we all work for this purpose..

First activities of the organization date back to the year 2003 when group of active young people got together to organize a youth exchange. After that there have been many local regional activities concerning integration, adventure tourism and different interest specific activities.

Members of Seiklejate Vennaskond meet regularly to put their ideas into practice and develop new projects and activities. All activities are organized by volunteers and voluntarily. There are members all over Estonia in the organization and there are even regional grouping like in Hiiumaa and Saaremaa.

The main age group of members is from 16 to 35. Many members come from rural/remote areas, so Seiklejate Vennaskond has also young people with fewer opportunities involved in the organization.





## Hungary – UTON Lfjusagi

We founded On The Way Association in 2004. Our goals are to help intercultural learning processes, tolerance Programmes and to promote 'culture of peace'. Since the beginning of 2009 we have two Youth camps. One of them is near the famous stalactite cavern, Aggtelek the other one is on the shore of lake Balaton.

We also have a second office in a less-developed city (Balkány) where we provide different kinds of free services for the youth living nearby (job-seeking training, English courses, etc)

We would like to be part of sharing experiences and best practices between neighbouring nations and other European countries.

We also organized EVS related programme (for example pre departure trainings, EVS Clubs).

Our activities are:

- organizing local, regional, national and international youth programs
- youth exchanges
- trainings, seminars
- EVS volunteers

We operate an office in a less-developed town where we provide free education and trainings to the youth living nearby; we are national coordinators of EU programs like EAD, Eiroposer and Eurocartoon.

We do networking and contacting on national and international levels.





## **Polonia- European Ass. of Young Regionalist**

European Association of Young Regionalists (ESMR) was founded in 1999. From the beginning its activity is strictly connected with Slaskie voivodship and Katowice where the association has its headquarters.

The founders, members and participants of our projects are mainly inhabitants of that region.

Main aims of the association are: promoting co-operation and youth exchange, supporting European integration, domestic and foreign cultural and scientific co-operation with people and institutions, acting against unemployment among youth, projects for disabled people, supporting Poles living abroad.

Really happy to be part of this project. I will start studying English!

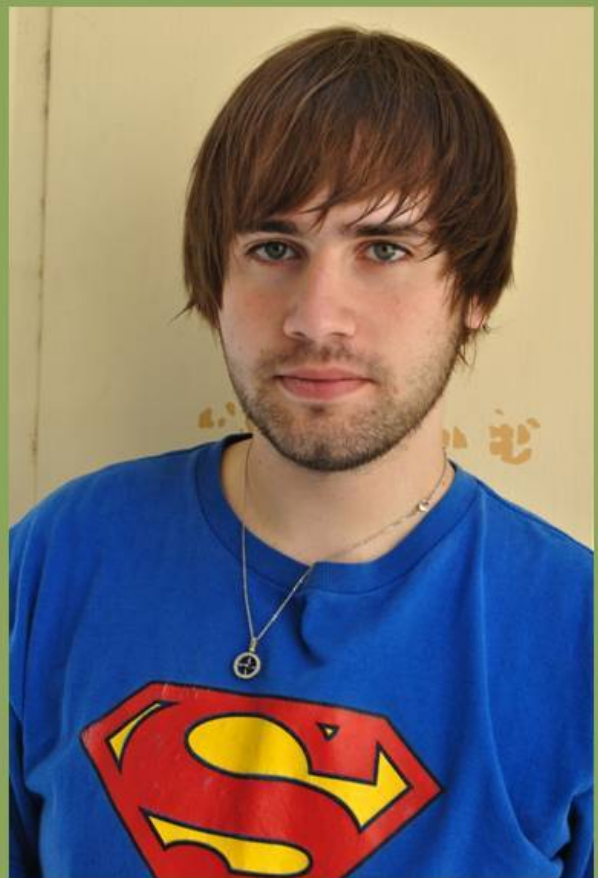
# KUBA
